Terms and conditions

I am applying to the Master of Science in Psychology program with the knowledge that the following features of the program likely impact my admission to the program and success in the completion of this program should I be admitted:

During application:

- I understand that all application materials must be received by the deadline (not just the application): June 1 for Fall admission, October 1 for Spring admission.
- I attest that my application materials, in particular, the essay, are my own work and an accurate reflection of my academic writing skills.
- I understand that English proficiency should be demonstrated in the supporting application materials that I submit.
- I understand that letters of recommendation should not come from personal references. Professional and academic references are required.

Once admitted to the program:

- I understand that I must maintain an overall GPA of at least a 3.0 throughout the program.
- I understand that I must earn a grade of B- or higher in each course to remain in good standing, make academic progress, and graduate from the program.
- I understand that to successfully complete this program, I must demonstrate graduate level English proficiency in both written and oral formats.
 - Successful completion of this program will necessitate completing several long-written assignments, including but not limited to a final Capstone paper.
- I understand that for all formats of the program, hybrid and online, I will be required to attend weekly, scheduled class meetings either in person (if admitted in the fall) or virtually (via teleconferencing software, if admitted in the spring).
 - Scheduling is announced prior to each semester, including upon admission offer. Schedules are released at least one month in advance of the following semester.
 - I understand that the class schedule may change from one semester to the next.
- I understand that I will be required to complete a supervised practicum experience during the second, third and final semester of the program.
 - This experience requires that I meet minimum monthly BCBA certification requirements as set by the 2022 BACB standards of supervised fieldwork.

 - I understand that the practicum experience can only be completed at an approved affiliated site or place of employment (if using employment, I will require additional program approval).
